Dear Councilor,

Beyond the supervisor from the city water department who came out to my home, I have not heard back from anyone from the city. Although the movements and vibrations have lessened as the city continues to add access ways and landscape to our new fire house, I can tell you that occasional shifts are still felt. These movements may have also lessened as the result of work done by the city or state to extend the new retaining wall keeping the Route 1A overpass from sliding into the bus stop, which is in-line with my property.

Please let me know when I can expect to hear back from Building Inspector Benjamin DeChristoforo. I'd also be interested in reviewing the maps and other data you and Chief of Infrastructure Christopher Ciaramella have reviewed to rule out any infrastructure issues. In the more immediate time frame, I'd like to file some type of formal notice with the city outlining my concerns so that the city and/or its builders can be held accountable.

Also, I was wrong when I said that the traffic noise coming from Lynn was more of a problem than that headed towards it. The noise is equal or perhaps even louder when large diesel trucks climb up and over the shifting Route 1A overpass. I'm interested if you've had a chance to speak with your colleagues about possible noise suppression walls for Route 1A.

Finally, the noise has also been an issue on the Route 1A overpass as the city and state appear to be moving forward with a plan to modify Route 1A access roads during the overnight hours. I hope the this road work is not planned for the overnight hours.

Hi Angela,

A supervisor from the city water department came out to my home today. I think his name was Anthony.

I shared with him my concerns, pointing out the large crack that has opened up in the street in front of my home and that now appears to be extending into my driveway. I was also able to point out areas in the back of my home where the foundation appears to be showing signs of stress. This is in an area of my back yard where I have felt the earth move under foot.

He suggested I hire a structural engineer to examine my property and if necessary file a claim with the city. I explained that even if I were to do what he suggested, it wouldn't solve the immediate problem that is causing my house to vibrate and shake when heavy loads are put on the Lynnway road in front of the new firehouse.

He told me that he would be reporting back to city hall my issues. When he asked what I would like the city to do, I told him that first and foremost the city needs to fix the issue that is causing the earth to move around my home. The problems are tied directly to the work done on the Lynnway in front of the new Alden Mills Firehouse and at the end of my street Alden Ave.

**Note:** The problem can be best seen during early or late rush hour when MBTA buses are able to transit on and off Route 1A without a lot of traffic to slow them down. These problems will only get worse over time, and I worry about major structural damage being done to my home if this is not already the case.

Additionally, I asked if the city could look into solutions to mitigate the noise issues introduced by these two new structures along the highway. As we discussed on the phone this past Monday, traffic noise bounces off these two large buildings and is amplified into the Point of Pines. This is especially true of the traffic coming over the General Edwards Bridge from Lynn and headed towards Logan Airport.

I'd like to follow up with you and the city attorney when you return from vacation to see what our options are. In my opinion no additional payments should be made to these developers until they are able to address these issues.

Thank you for your follow-up. I want to reassure you that I've been working to address your concerns, even while I'm currently away this week on a previously scheduled vacation.

I understand you believe recent construction projects — including the new firehouse and a residential development on the opposite side of Route 1A — are contributing to vibrations at your home. After speaking with the Chief of Infrastructure Christopher Ciaramella, I've reviewed the current condition of your property and surrounding infrastructure. While there is no evidence linking these projects to the issues you've described, I take all resident concerns seriously and want to ensure you feel heard.

I've reached out to Building Inspector Benjamin DeChristoforo to follow up on the outreach you mentioned and have asked that he review the matter and advise on any appropriate next steps.

As the Ward 5 City Councilor, I am your direct representative in this matter. No other City Councilors would be notified or involved unless a citywide matter were brought forward.

Thank you for your patience as I continue to coordinate with the appropriate departments. I'll follow up with you once I have more information.
