

Dear Councillor,

I am a constituent of yours and a neighbor living at 8 Alden Ave here in the Point of Pines. I am contacting you to report damage to the street in front of my home that has been caused by all of the construction going on down here in the Point of Pines.

The same problem that has caused a large crack to appear in the street in front of my home, that is now causing damage to my driveway, has also been causing my home to vibrate and bounce at varying degrees and levels for the past two years. These problem become worse based on the weight, speed, and amount of traffic traveling on the Lynnway road between my home and our new firehouse.

Because we've had two non-minor gas leaks in front of my house in the last year that have required immediate service, I contacted National Grid on Tuesday April 1, 2025. They came out to my home for a safety check, but told me their lines were not the cause of the earth movement. That same morning I also contacted the Revere Building Inspector's Office, and I believe I spoke with Benjamin DeChristoforo who called me back later that day. He told me he was going to talk to people from the Revere Fire Department, and possibly the Revere DPW, and that he would get back to me. I still have not heard back from anyone.

I have an appointment Monday morning but will be around all afternoon. I'd appreciate a call back so that I know someone is working to fix this problem. I will try calling you at the number listed on the [revere.org](http://revere.org) website later in the day if I have not heard back from you first.
