On July 22, 2022, the Northeast Regional Office of the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection, Wetlands Program (MassDEP), appealed the issuance of an Order of Conditions, which was issued by the Revere Conservation Commission (the Commission) for the project referenced above on July 11, 2022.

On August 18, 2022, MassDEP conducted a site inspection with you and your representatives and other interested parties. At the site visit MassDEP observed existing conditions with a focus on the location of Coastal Dune and Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage. As a result of observations made at the site visit, MassDEP hereby withdraws the appeal. This withdrawal thereby abrogates any further action by MassDEP in this matter. The Order of Conditions issued by the Commission on July 11, 2022, shall be the Final Order for this project.
